

LEARNING CENTER THREE: CREATE-A-COMIC



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This center will allow you to create your own comic strip based on the events in the story, "Flowers for Algernon." Through this project you should demonstrate your comprehension of the story and the various main events that help the flow of the plot.

INSTRUCTION CARD

Create-A-Comic

1. Materials options: poster board, 11x14 art paper, bulletin board paper, markers. Paint, mixed media, collage. (lined paper and pencil not accepted)
2. **Outline of Events Sheet:** This will reflect the chronological order of your comic and story order. Final is typed. Learning Center# and Title at the top of page.
3. **Requirements:** 1.) Your comic should have no less than (9) nine frames but you may have more. 2.) Use of at least one onomatopoeia. 3,) Very colorful with 95% color and very little white spaces. Neatness counts.
4. **Frame requirements:** frame number in upper right hand corner, dialogue from at least one character, and a caption either at the bottom, top, or side. Determine the difference between a thought bubble and a conversation bubble.
5. **Completed Comic:** Your comic should have a beginning, middle, and an end. It will reflect the story and flow well, demonstrating your knowledge of the plot. **It will include main ideas and summarize the story.**
